3) Mold Me - A Soft and Pliable Vessel

Go down to the potter's house and there I will give you my message. So I went down to the potter's house, and I saw him working at the wheel. But the pot he was shaping from the clay was marred in his hand; so the potter formed it into another pot, shaping it as seemed best to him. (Jeremiah 18:1-4)

A)...Add more water before I become too brittle!

4) Fill Me - Preparing the Vessel

A)...I'm Ready For Battle
